How does parking impact cities?

"Free parking" is not free Everyone in cities pays for parking through

- time
- higher costs of goods
- poor air quality
- unsafe streets

Parking minimums generate more parking than the market demands, resulting in:

- Inefficient use of space
- Housing and service shortages
- Threats to urban fabric
- Costs to build and maintain parking facilities

Leverage political will at the right level of government






Communicate plans for reform using messaging that resonates with people
