POLICY AND LEGISLATIVE

- UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities- ratified by Kenya in 2008
- SDGs 3.6, 11.2
- Kenya Constitution 2010-Bill of Rights
- Disability Act, 2003 (*Amended 2025*)
- Nairobi County Non Motorized Transport Policy

WHY UNIVERSAL ACCESS

- Universal accessibility is about ensuring that all people, whatever their condition, have **free** and **equal access** to all spaces, **services and infrastructure**
- ▶ Access to education, employment, health care, social activities
- ▶ Reduces dependency and poverty
- ▶ Links directly to sustainable development
- ▶ Accessibility- Availability, Affordability, Safety are key to inclusion

Barriers

- Policy and regulation-need universal design principles
- Physical-land use
- Mobility systems not inclusive-Transport
- Attitudinal
- Decision making-not participatory
- Leads to exclusion
