



Public Transport is the backbone of urban life



What are we calling Public Transport?

- Publicly available
- Shared service that carry multiple passengers
- Operates mostly along fixed routes
- Predictable and consistent

Including both formal and informal systems.



How can we provide Good Public Transport?



- Deliver strong service, clean fleets, and inclusive systems
- Recognize that quality does not happen by accident
- Build on strong, lasting foundations

Good Service



- Fast and Frequent operation
- Reliable service
- Integrated planning and service

Enables access, trust, and daily usability.



Zero Emissions



- Clean energy powered vehicles
- Quieter, more comfortable service
- Healthier, more resilient cities
